

Seminole High School Transportation Plan

9th Grade Center

Morning Drop Off

- All buses will report to the main campus first, drop off all 10th through 12th graders and then proceed to the Ninth Grade Center (NGC) to drop off the 9th grade students.
- 9th Graders taking 1st period classes at main campus will be dropped at main campus.
- Drop off at the main campus will start at 6:35 and the drop off for the NGC will begin at 6:45.
- The start times will be staggered to accommodate a 10-minute allowance so the buses can drop off at both locations.

Afternoon Pick-Up

- Approximately half of the buses will report to the NGC and park to wait for dismissal of 9th grade students.
- Remaining buses will proceed to the SHS main campus to pick up the 10th through 12th grade students.
- The SHS main campus buses will then shuttle the 10th through 12th grade students to the NGC for transfer to their assigned buses.
- The release times have been staggered to allow the buses to get to the NGC on time. The main campus will release at 2:10 and the NGC will release at 2:20.

Issues Taken Into Consideration

- Shuttling of the older 10th through 12th grade students
- Putting the buses at the main campus that have the most 10th through 12th graders assigned.
- Redesign the existing bus loop at Millennium to allow for all the buses to pull onto the ramp.
- Change of traffic pattern to allow for a smoother transition for the buses to maneuver.
