Tardy Hero is a new software program that Seminole High School will be utilizing to document tardies and hopefully to reduce the incidences of tardies during the school day.

Students were made aware of the new software program on Wednesday, October 18, 2017, during our Advisement period. We will begin utilizing the program on Monday, October 23rd.

Attendance is **important** because students are more likely to succeed in academics when they attend school consistently. It's difficult for the teacher and the class to build their skills and progress if a large number of students are frequently absent.

Students are expected to be **punctual** and dependable in order to take advantage of instructional time. When students are absent or tardy, learning is interrupted and grades are typically negatively affected.

Students who are late for class will need to go to the classroom building office closest to their classroom for a pass. There, the secretary will scan their student identification card.

- 2nd tardy: More Urgent Warning
- 3rd tardy: Lunch Detention
- 4th tardy: 1 hour Wednesday School
- 5th tardy: 1 hour Wednesday School /Work Detail
- 6th tardy: Parent Conference Saturday school
- 7th tardy and more – Disciplinary Referral /Administrative Discipline
