Scholarship Competition

Purpose & Competition Details

The purpose of the Mr. and Miss SHS scholarship competition is to select a young man and woman to represent Seminole High School, its students and its faculty. Mr. and Miss SHS showcase young man and women from across the entire campus and recognizes their achievements, hard work, and service to the school and community. Each young man and woman competing for scholarships and the Mr. and Miss SHS title is considered an outstanding achievement in their campus club, team, or organization.

Mr. and Miss SHS serve as the school's student hostess at events and meetings scheduled on campus and also escorts visitors, such as business partners and parents of prospective students, on tours of Seminole High School. Mr. and Miss SHS also serve on various student advisory committees and represents students at meetings and ceremonies.

The objectives of the Mr. and Miss Seminole High School Scholarship Competition are to:

- Recognize Seminole High School's outstanding young man and women
- Provide an opportunity for the school's outstanding young man and women to gain poise, polish, and experience and to grow in confidence and self-esteem
- Encourage campus involvement, service, and academics
- Select a campus representative
- Encourage the community's involvement

Miss SHS is sponsored and hosted by Seminole High School's PTSA (Parent-Teacher-Student Association) and Seminole High School.

Scoring

Points are awarded as follows:

Essay	30 points	Talent	30points
Interview	40 points		

Essay- 500-word essay submitted with the application

Interview- Individual interview with the judges. Business professional attire required

Talent- No more than four (4) minutes in length on the day of the competition. If music is being used, a CD of the music must be submitted one week in advance. If the talent is vocals/singing, the music track may not contain lyrics or vocals. Talents may take on a variety of forms. Approval will be discussed in the first meeting.

Judges' Question- You will have up to one (1) minute to answer a question which is posed by the judges during the competition.

Scholarships

Mr. And Miss Seminole High School will receive a check for \$1,000. The first runner-up will receive \$750 and the second runner-up will receive \$500.
