Parent Notes will be accepted to excuse student absences that result from student illness (SCPS Student Code of Conduct) or from the list below.

- 1. Medical treatment provided by a licensed health professional-via official document. This includes, but not limited to, a doctor, orthodontist, dentist, chiropractor, psychologist, vision, etc.
- 2. Observance of religious practices or a religious holiday.
- 3. Law enforcement order or court subpoena-via subpoena document.
- 4. Death of an immediate family member-parent note will be accepted in this circumstance.
- 5. Traffic accident that directly involved the student-via accident report.
- 6. College visits for Junior and Seniors- 2 days per year via official document. (This does not include colleges that visit the SHS campus)


