Advanced Placement Test Performance 2021-2022 Data



Seminole High School administered 2259 Advanced Placement exams in 28 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, US Government and Politics, World History, and Human Geography.

SHS had an average **pass rate of 52%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores Class of 2022



All juniors and seniors at SHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Seminole High School SAT score is **980** out of 1600.

PSAT Scores 2021-2022 Data



SHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

SHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **918** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness 2021-2022 Data

60% of SHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

SHS also offers **17 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Safety Manager and WordPress Certified Editor. In total, students earned **527 industry certifications**.

Seminole High School had a **91%** graduation rate for the Class of 2021.

SHS had over **858 Bright Futures** recipients, totalling over **\$7,862,814** in scholarships.

State Assessments 2021-2022 Data

Seminole High School earned a B grade from the Florida DOE in 2022.



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US News and World Report gave SHS a **Silver Medal** among public high schools reviewed on a national basis.

- SHS had a 100% pass rate on the Certified Nursing Asst (CNA) certification exam, along w/earning 260 Adobe and Microsoft certifications.
- In 2021, SHS was awarded International Baccalaureate Merit and Health Academy School of Distinction.
- We offer numerous extracurricular activities along with a top notch athletic program with multiple state championships!
- We offer one of the state's best marching band, "Pride of the Tribe", National Champion Dance Team "Dazzlers", Orchestra, Chorus, & Theatre.
